If the stakes are not fully subscribed novice dogs may enter.

Please state clearly on the entry form your dog`s qualification for Open Stake.

The meet for stake 1 and 2 will be at Toughers Restaurant on old Naas/Newbridge Rd Exit J10 M7 and follow the Newbridge sign on R445 (approx 3km from J10)

Meet at 8.00am on day 1 and at 9.00am on day 2, 3 and 4.

The meet for Stake 3 will take place at Clanard Court Hotel, Kilcullen Rd., Athy, Co. Kildare at 9.00am each day.

The Draw will take place at the meet each day.

In the event of any stake having less than 31 dogs the stake will be run on the first day.
